Church Weekend Away 6th-8th March 2026



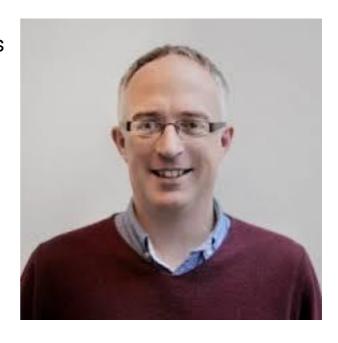
Our Church holiday has been booked at Quinta, a Christian Retreat centre just outside Oswestry in North Wales.

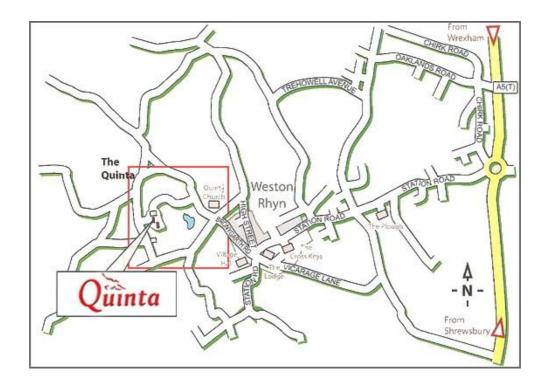

Where?

Quinta is about a 1hr15 drive from Liverpool SY10 7LR (lifts will be available). Quinta is in the Countryside near Oswestry. The main building that we use is a large Victorian country house, with bedrooms of varying sizes. The types of beds in rooms are varied, including doubles, singles and bunks. There are toilets, baths and shower facilities at various points around the building and there are also a limited number of en-suite bedrooms.



What to Bring:

Beds and bunks at Quinta are equipped with a mattress cover, two pillows and an uncovered duvet. You will need to bring one of the following options per person*:

- two pillowcases, bottom sheet and duvet cover, OR
- two pillowcases and a sleeping bag
